Pursuant to Ordering Paragraph (“OP”) 1 of the *Administrative Law Judge’s Ruling Seeking Comment on Proposed 2023 Preferred System Plan and Transmission Planning Process Portfolios*, dated October 5, 2023 (“ALJ Ruling”), Desert Community Energy (“DCE”) hereby submits updated information related to its 2022 Integrated Resource Plan (“IRP”), which was filed in this docket on November 1, 2022.

I. UPDATED INFORMATION SUPPORTING DCE’S 2022 IRP

Subsequent to DCE’s submission of its original 2022 IRP filing, the California Public Utilities Commission’s (“Commission”) Energy Division requested that certain supporting documents be updated or modified, including DCE’s Resource Data Template (“RDT”) spreadsheets. The ALJ Ruling requests that load serving entities (“LSEs”) that have updated their supporting documents pursuant to Energy Division request “make a formal filing in the docket of this proceeding with the final version of their RDT and/or [Clean System Power] calculator, by no

later than October 16, 2023, to ensure that the record reflects their correct information.”¹ DCE hereby submits the following documents in response to the ALJ Ruling:

- DCE_rdtv3_25 MMT_preferred_conforming_na_v1_revised_12.23.2022 - DCE’s Revised 25 MMT Resource Data Template (Confidential and Public Versions)
- DCE_rdtv3_30 MMT_preferred_conforming_na_v1_revised_12.23.2022 - DCE’s Revised 30 MMT Resource Data Template (Confidential and Public Versions)

DCE is filing the confidential, unredacted, versions of its revised RDTs under seal with the Commission’s Docket Office in accordance with relevant Commission rules and procedures. DCE is publicly filing the public, redacted, versions of its revised RDTs through a Notice of Availability, which provides links to the public versions of DCE’s updated 2022 IRP documents. DCE’s updated 2022 IRP materials are provided through the following attachments:

- Attachment A: Notice of Availability of Desert Community Energy’s 2022 Integrated Resource Plan (Revisions)

The remainder of DCE’s IRP materials, including its 2022 IRP Narrative, Clean System Power (“CSP”) spreadsheets, and IRP Verification, were not subject to update requests and remain unchanged from the originally filed versions.

II. CONFIDENTIALITY REQUEST

The ALJ Ruling provides that “if [an] LSE already filed a Motion to File Under Seal with its original submission, an additional motion with the corrected/updated filing is not required.”² DCE’s original 2022 IRP was filed concurrently with a Motion to File Under Seal, which sought confidential treatment of certain categories of information provided in DCE’s IRP filing, including its RDT documents. The information being provided in DCE’s updated material is consistent with the information provided in DCE’s original 2022 IRP submission, and DCE requests that the same

information categories covered by DCE Motion to File Under Seal be protected in this updated filing.
